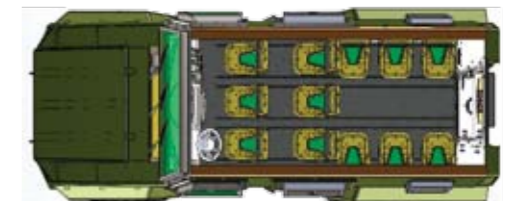
The Tiger Mk II capsule is a spacious “box”, with a unique flat floor throughout the entire cabin, from firewall to rear door. The wide, flat-floored cabin allows for three front-row seats, comfortably seating passengers in full battle gear. Configurations include driver, navigator and commander, or driver and two security personnel. Five doors and seat mounting floor rails enable various interchangeable seating arrangements, including seating for six or eight forward facing passengers, or six forward facing and six side-by-side passengers.

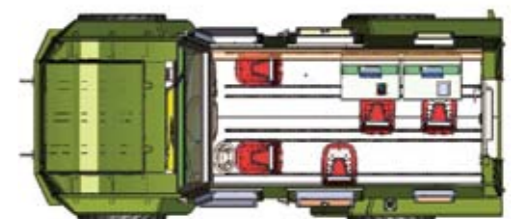
